### Reminder

- Waitlists were cleared, but students may enroll in a course for which they were waitlisted if a seat becomes available. There will be no email notifications of vacant seats. If you would like to know which students were on the waitlist at the close of registration, contact your department administrator.
- Your Canvas roster is the best source for an up-to-date list of registered students. If a student is officially enrolled in your course, they will appear on your Canvas roster with a "Student" status. Persons on your roster with a "Visitor" status have not officially enrolled.
