

## HOW TO COMPARE COURSE EVALUATIONS

If you are a student whose school allows you to view course evaluations, you will be able to view and compare course evaluations for the courses in your school.

- You must login to Yale Course Search to access course evaluations
- Begin by performing a regular course search.
- Select a course to view course information.
- In the “Course Resources” section, click on Course evaluations:
